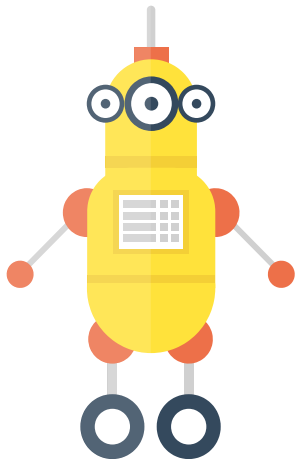

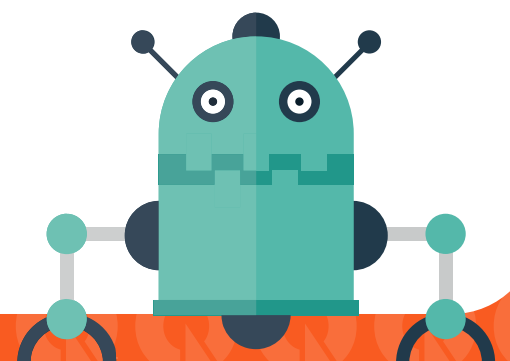

Non-profit organisations

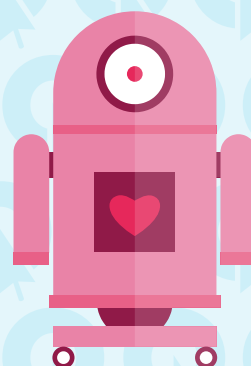
can organise and promote workshops and coding events.
